If you can't come by boat, fly into Reagan National Airport or Baltimore-Washington International Airport, or take the train to DC. Both are about $1\frac{1}{2}$ hours drive away. Usually, half of our attendees travel by land or air from around the world.

The registration cost per member is estimated to be about \$150. (We're working on the budget now.) Registration forms will be available in early spring.

Thursday, Oct. 13 th :	NOTE: First day of the Annapolis Power Boat Show.

Spring Cove Marina is rated 5 stars on Active Captain. The Wheelhouse Bar and Grill at poolside has a full service bar with a good menu. There are many other restaurants within walking distance of Spring Cove Marina and the marina offers complimentary local transportation by van. The special DFC slip rate will be \$ 2.00 per foot, fourth night free, and discounted electricity. Weekly and monthly discounted rates are also available to DFC. You can call the marina to reserve your slip right now at (410) 326-2161, but be sure to say "DeFever Cruisers" for the special rate. Our first night Docktail party at the marina will include a boaters' flea market so bring some of those wonderful treasures that you've been storing in your boat or garage. **The Solomons Island Yacht Club** will open their doors to the DF Cruisers on Saturday night for cocktails and dinner. And, by popular demand, we will once again have the fabulous Live Auction!

Holiday Inn Solomons Conference Center is a short walk from Spring Cove Marina and will be the venue for our seminars and silent auction. It's an easy walk from the marina to the hotel. Holiday Inn amenities include on-site Isaac's Restaurant & Pub, Fitness Center & Sauna, Tennis Courts, Jr. Olympic Pool, and Marina with boat slips. Many rooms offer beautiful water views. DFC has reserved 30 King or Double bed rooms at a special price of \$129.00 and 5 suites at \$159.00. The weekend of October 7th will be busy at Solomons, so make your reservations now (410) 326-6311.

The United States (Annapolis) Power Boat Show starts October 13th, just three days after our rendezvous ends. In its 44th year, this is the world's oldest in-water powerboat show. Those who are traveling by boat can easily make the trip north to the Annapolis area in approximately 4 hours. By car it will take you an hour and fifteen minutes. If you decide to attend the show, we recommend that you make slip or hotel reservations now.

The Calvert Marine Museum will be the focal point of our Monday activities. It's an exceptional museum featuring the history of the Chesapeake Bay area. We will have a private tour of the museum and a cruise on one of the historic vessels. Special exhibits include the Drum Point Light, the bugeye *Wm. B. Tennison*, and the J. C. Lore Oyster House. The latter two are National Historic Landmarks. It will be a relaxed day with friends.
